RETURN TO TRAINING GUIDELINES - ASSOCIATION FLOW CHART

COMMUNICATE

- Communicate with your clubs/teams that you have received the guidelines from Netball WA and you are meeting to develop a COVID-19 Plan
- Contact your Local Government Authority (LGA) for advice on their position regarding your venue.

SELF EDUCATION

- All committee to complete COVID-19 Infection Control training and collect all Association certificates and keep on file.
- Read the Sport and Recreation COVID-19 Safety Guidelines
- Read all of the Netball WA Return to Netball documents including the Return to Community Netball Guidelines, Return to Training Protocols, guidelines and FAQ's

PREPARE

- Conduct a briefing with clubs to notify them of your Association plan, including your hygiene plan in accordance with the Return to Training Guidelines
- Assessment and Preparation of the netball environment and any key dates to allow you to plan for stage 3.
- Collect Intent to Train forms from your clubs to develop a training schedule in accordance with the COVID-19 Safety Guidelines and LGA requirements

TRAIN

- Develop a roster for a committee member to be present each training night during the first week to answer questions or provide assistance to those teams.
- Ensure teams are adhering to the Association guidelines.
- Display COVID-19 Responsibilities posters around your venue
