

2020 PERTH NAIDOC CARNIVAL GRAND FINAL PROCEDURES

Grand Final matches will see the top two (2) teams of each division play-off against each other following the completion of the minor round matches, as per the below competition format:

- Grand Final: 1st ladder placing vs 2nd ladder placing

QUALIFICATION AND PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

- To qualify to play in finals, players must have participated in a minimum of three (3) matches for their team during the minor round matches of the competition.
- Any team and/or player that does not meet the player minimum match requirements will not be eligible to play in the finals.
- This will be determined via the details entered on the scorecard during the fixture matches.
- For the purpose of determining if a player has played a half, this occurs once a player has taken the court, irrespective of the amount of time the player remains on the court during that half. If the player comes off injured at any time during that half, it is still counted for both that player and any player that replaces them.

SCORING AND TIMING

- Scoring and timing procedures are to be adhered to as per minor round matches; the first mentioned team shall collect official score card (from the corresponding match office) and shall provide the scorer for the match.
- The Grand Final matches will be centralised timed by Netball WA from the PNA Match Office and GNC Match Office.

DRAWN MATCH

- In the event of a draw in a Grand Final match, there shall be a one-minute break, during which the umpires shall confirm with the scorer that the match is a draw.
- Positional changes may **not** be made at this time.
- The match shall recommence with the centre pass being taken by the team due to take the centre pass and the match shall proceed until one team has scored a two-goal advantage.
- The scorer shall alert the umpires when this has occurred.

STOPPAGES/INJURY TIME

- Stoppages will **not** be allowed during Grand Final matches.
