GOLD INDUSTRY GROUP COMMUNITY GOAL POST PAD SCHEME PURPOSE

Through the Community Goal Post Pad Scheme, the Gold Industry Group aims to improve netball facilities across WA by providing new goal post pads to Netball WA's Associations and Clubs. This scheme is the first to be developed to ensure our associations have access to quality infrastructure and equipment that underpins the sustainability of netball among our communities.

ABOUT THE GIG PARTNERSHIP

PROGRAM PRIORITY

The Gold Industry Group Community Goal Post Pad Scheme (GIG CGPPS) is available to all Associations and Clubs affiliated with Netball WA. Funding priority will be given to:

- Requests that are of strategic value to Netball WA and the Gold Industry Group

FUNDING ARRANGEMENTS AND CONDITIONS

- Acknowledgement of the contribution by Netball WA and the Gold Industry Group needs to be publicly promoted and a representative of the Gold Industry Group must be invited to attend a presentation where possible.
- Associations and Clubs must be affiliated with Netball WA.
- Associations and Clubs must be incorporated.
- Infrastructure equipment will be purchased direct through a Netball WA preferred supplier.



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- The applicant must provide photographic evidence to Netball WA on receiving the goal post pads.
- Funds are limited and the long-term availability of the fund is not guaranteed.
- Recurring replacement costs of pads will not be funded.

30 MARCH – 22 APRIL 2021
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applications must be submitted by prescribed closing date or they will be ineligible to receive goal post pads.• The GIG CGPPS Assessment Panel meets to determine recommendations for allocation.
29 APRIL 2021
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The GIG CGPPS Assessment Panel considers recommendations and approves production.• Associations and Clubs will be notified of the outcome.• The Goal Post Pad order will be submitted for production and distributed once produced.

ASSESSMENT PROCESS

Applications which do not address all questions and sections within the application form, may not be considered.

The GIG CGPPS Assessment Panel will recommend an allocation of pads for any successful application, within the scope of the GIG CGPPS budget. Applications will be ranked in order of strategic importance by the Panel, with recommended applications submitted to the Chief Executive Officer for review and approval.
