I was also one of the original License holders for West Coast Warriors NC when the WA Netball League changed direction to Licenses once the Regions folded. I was President of the Warriors Netball Club for their first two years under that License. I am a Life Member of WDNA. I was also part of the NWA Men's Netball Working Group.</p> <p>Through my association with both WDNA and the West Coast Netball Region, I have had significant interaction with our Local Government staff and councillors (the City of Wanneroo), with regards to the future planning for netball infrastructure in the northern corridor.
