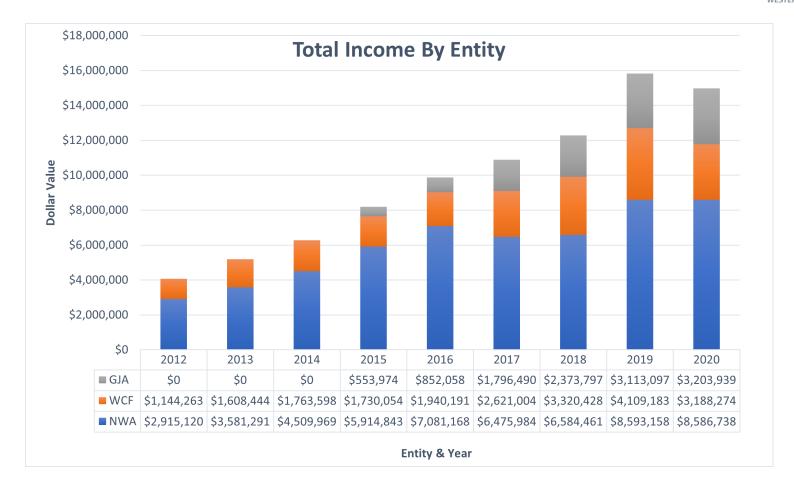
Financial Overview – Consolidated Revenue

Income by Entity





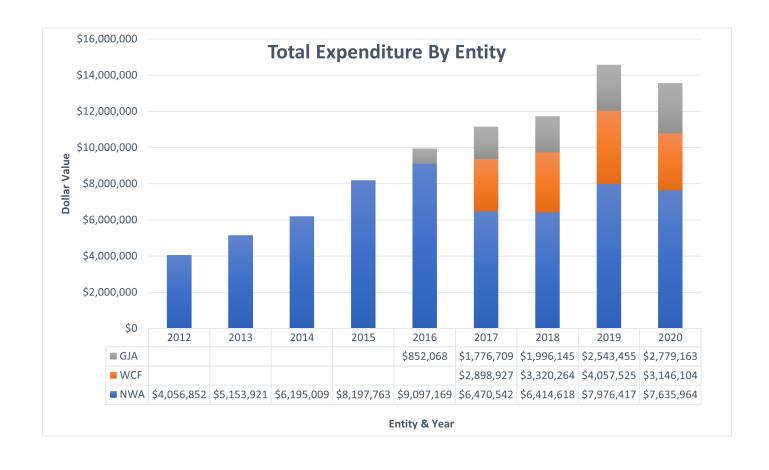


Financial Overview – Consolidated Expenditure





Expenditure by Entity





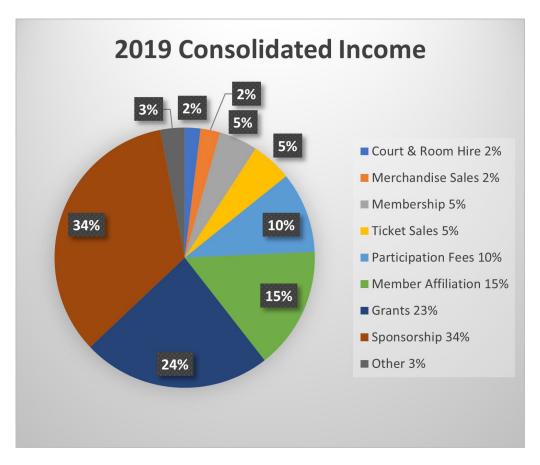


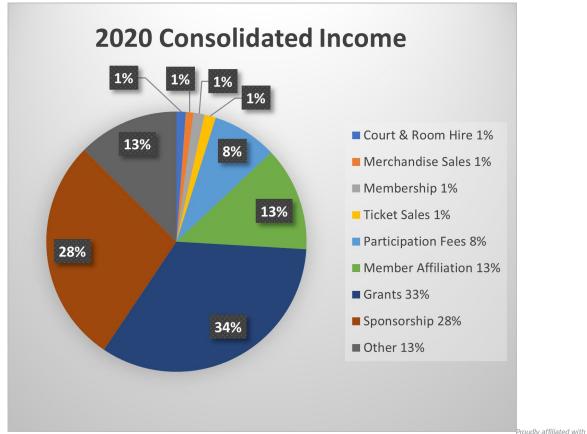

2020 Consolidated Income by Type





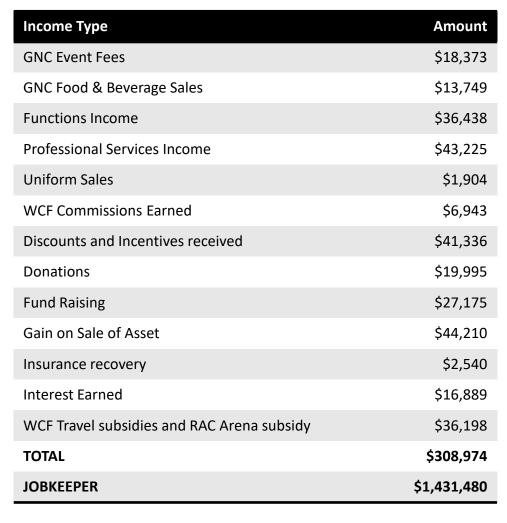

Items included in the "other" income category







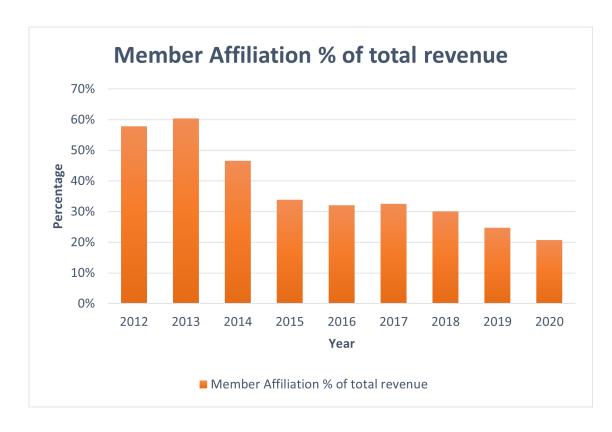


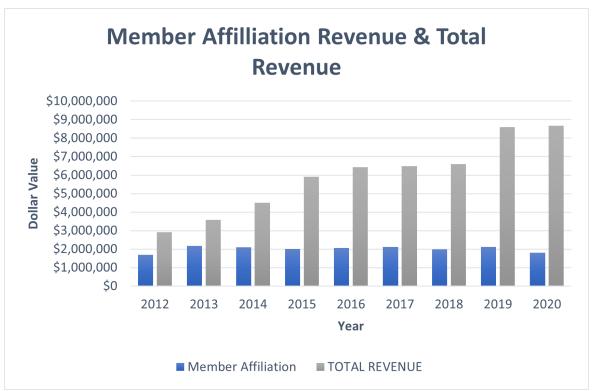


Financial Overview - Revenue

NWA Membership Income as % of Total Consolidated Income









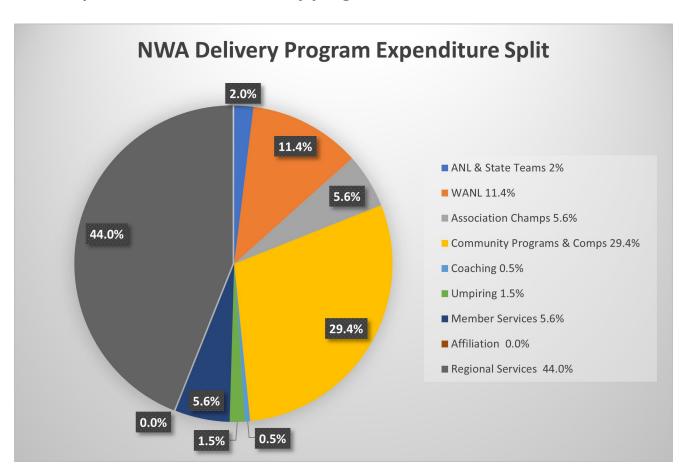


Financial Overview – NWA Expenditure

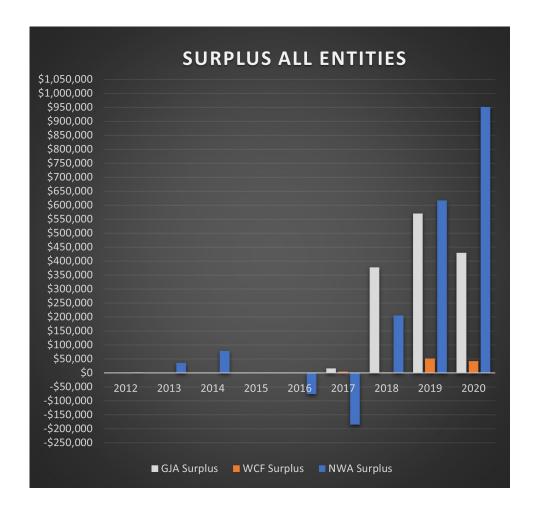

While the result is pleasing given the challenges confronted throughout 2020, it is anticipated the surplus will largely be consumed in 2021 as there is no expectation of COVID-19 relief grants being received again.

7. Confirmation of Elected Directors

Clause 14.1(a): nominees for Elected Director positions on the Board must meet the qualifications as prescribed from time to time by the Board

Three qualifications identified:

- Government Relations 1 nominee
- Legal 0 nominees (reverts to a Casual Vacancy under clause 14.2(i))
- Local Government, Facilities & Sports Administration 2 nominees (contested vote)

Electronic voting opened on 19 March and closed on 26 March 2021.

Clause 14.2(i)(ii) states that the nominations must receive endorsement of 50% or more of the Voting Members. There are currently 22 Voting Members. Only 10 votes were cast, resulting in an invalid vote.

All three positions will now be filled as Casual Vacancies in accordance with the Casual Vacancy Policy.









Casual Vacancy Process

- NWA Board determines skills required on the NWA Board for proposed candidates (eligibility criteria)
- Netball WA Nominations Committee will prepare an expression of interest
- The Casual Vacancy will be advertised, and the NWA Board will be asked to put forward prospective candidates based on the eligibility criteria
- Candidates to submit CV and any other documentation that maybe required
- Nominations Committee will assess candidates and prepare a shortlist
- Two or more members of the Nominations Committee will interview the shortlisted candidates
- Nominations Committee will prepare an evaluation report, including a recommendation on the preferred candidates, and present this to the NWA Board
- The NWA Board will review the recommendation from the Nominations Committee and review each shortlisted candidate to assess:
 - Their commitment to a strong governance regime and developing policies and strategies for netball in WA
 - If the candidate is free from any interest/relationship that would materially interfere with their ability to act in the best interests of NWA
 - If the appointment of the candidate will enhance the balance and diversity of skills among Directors
 - That the candidate satisfies the eligibility criteria
- The President and CEO of NWA will meet with the preferred candidate and formally advise of the appointment
