

2022 FAY BEVAN UMPIRE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Applications must demonstrate ability and/or evidence towards the following criteria to apply for the Fay Bevan Umpiring Scholarship;

- Applicants must be affiliated member of Netball WA;
- Applicants must be 15 years of age or over;
- Applicants must have a valid current Working with Children Check Card;
- Applicants must be umpiring at Association, State or National level;
- Applicants must have as a minimum, a current C Badge Umpiring Accreditation;
- Applicants must have completed the current Rules of Netball Theory Online Exam (2020 International Netball Federation rules);
- Applicants must demonstrate commitment to furthering their umpiring development and the desire to attain higher badge levels;
- Applicants must be prepared, if deemed necessary by Netball WA, to develop and implement an Individual Performance Plan;
- Applicants must be familiar with the Netball WA Strategic Plan and Vision and demonstrate the ability to support Netball WA values;
- Applicants must adhere to Netball WA sponsorship guidelines when representing Netball WA at any event whilst undertaking activities as part of the scholarship;
- Applicants must acquit all expenditure in line with the policy;
- **Full-time employees of Netball WA, West Coast Fever and WAIS are ineligible for this scholarship.**
