I hope that everyone enjoyed a well-deserved break over Christmas and has returned refreshed and ready for the 2022 netball season.

Thank you to those that have provided input and submitted inquiries regarding COVID-19 health directives so that we can be as prepared as possible for the forthcoming season.

With Premier Mark McGowan's latest announcement on Thursday 20 January, Netball WA is clarifying all queries and any latest information with WA Police and the State Government as we discuss how COVID-19 requirements in WA, including proof of vaccination, mask-wearing, event capacity, and a new border re-opening date are expected to impact community sport.

As soon as these details have been confirmed and official directives are received by Netball WA, this information will be shared so that we can all plan accordingly. Our primary focus is on the well-being of netball participants, and we will continue working with the State Government to implement health directives. We also encourage netball participants to get vaccinated to protect themselves and the community.
