

GIG Golden Moment Competition 2022 Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter this competition forms part of the Terms and Conditions of entry. Entry into this competition is deemed to be an acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. 4. Entry is open to all Netball WA followers, that reside in Western Australia.
5. Entry excludes any individual or group who are employed by Netball WA, including members of the board, officers, management, employees, and other staff (including, without limitation, prize suppliers).
