## Netball WA Coach Achievement Award

### Purpose

The Netball WA (NWA) Coach Achievement Award recognises the significant role and contribution community coaches play not only to their own coaching development but also in the development of players, clubs, and teams and within Western Australia.

### Service Period

The Award is for service during the **2023 calendar year**.

### Selection Criteria

The nominee for the Award must meet the following criteria:

1. Is a current registered member of NWA in the year nominated for.
2. Made a sustained contribution over the 12-month period.
3. Conduct themselves on and off the court in a professional, considerate manner exhibiting positive behaviours by:
  - Developing mutually respectful relationships with coaches, umpires, players, parents, and other officials.
  - Representing their Association or Club, upholding the integrity of the sport, operating within the local rules and the spirit of the game, and encouraging players and coaches to do the same.
4. Demonstrated improved performance, displaying sound knowledge and competency of the game through their understanding of rules, needs of players and coaching philosophy by:
  - Improving their standard of coaching through ongoing personal development, education, and mentoring.
  - Improving their ability as a coach and the ability of each team member, as well as to engage players with innovative skill ideas.
5. Contributed to their Association and Netball WA by:
  - Assisting in the development and mentoring of coaches.
  - Presenting coaching courses and workshops.

### Nomination Process

- Each Association may nominate one candidate for this Award.
- Nominations will only be accepted through the official nomination form. Incomplete/late nominations will not be accepted.
- A picture of the nominee is to be uploaded with the nomination.

### **Award Selection Panel**

The selection panel will consist of, but not limited to, the following Netball WA personnel, General Manager Community Netball, Stakeholder & Operations Manager and WCF Pathway Lead. In the event that any of the above members are unavailable NWA has the right to appoint another suitable representative to the selection panel.

### **Selection Process**

Nominations are submitted by each Association to NWA. The Awards Selection Panel chooses the Award recipient from the nominations received. The Awards Selection Panel decision is final.

### **Award Presentation**

Presentation of this Award will be at the Fuel to Go and Play Association Championships Opening Ceremony on the long weekend in June.

NWA will liaise with the relevant Association to arrange for the Award recipient to attend the Fuel to Go & Play Association Championships Opening Ceremony, where possible without the knowledge they are receiving an Award.
