Roles in Woolworths NetSetGo

Woolworths NetSetGo is more than just a sports program – it's a community. A community in which everybody plays a key position in nurturing a positive, and supportive environment.

THE COORDINATOR

As a centre coordinator, you're key to making Woolworths NetSetGo a fantastic experience. You'll ensure everything runs smoothly and create a welcoming environment for kids and families.

- + Recruiting new players to grow your centre.
- + Supporting new coaches as they join the program.
- + Providing feedback to Netball Australia for program improvements.
- + Using and promoting the Coaching and Delivery Resources for consistent sessions.

THE COACH

Coaches play a vital role in making Woolworths NetSetGo fun and rewarding. Whether a first-time or experienced coach. The coach's role is to inspire and guide kids while making sure everyone feels included.

- + Lead engaging, game-based activities to keep kids active and having fun. Supporting new coaches as they join the program.
- + Encourage equal participation so every child is involved.
- + Promote teamwork and inclusivity, helping kids make friends.
- + Give positive feedback to boost confidence and celebrate effort.
- + Adapt activities to match each child's development and ensure success.
- + Ensure safety by maintaining a supportive, welcoming environment.

Levels of progression (tiers)

Woolworths NetSetGo is open to all skill levels, welcoming kids who are new to the sport as well as those looking to extend their experience. We have three aged-based tiers; Net, Set, and Go. From catching and passing to learning how to be part of a team, each tier focuses on building confidence and skills at a pace that's right for them, whether they have played before or are picking up a ball for the first time.

NET

AGES 5-6
FUN FUNDAMENTALS

Engaging our littlest netballers with fun, modified equipment like bean bags and soft balls to introduce kids to the basics of movement and netball, building confidence and teamwork in a playful way.

SET

AGES 7-8
SHARPENING SKILLS

Helping kids practice netball skills, no matter their level of experience and play modified games with a smaller ball, perfect for refining movements and learning new strategies, all while keeping it lighthearted and loaded with fun.

GO!

AGES 9-10
GETTING GAME-READY

Helping budding netballers fine-tune their physical capabilities by getting ready for the next - or should we say net - level. With a size 4 ball and lower goal posts, they'll play modified matches, and maybe even keep score without losing sight of the fun.



Programs

A program is an 8-10 week block of sessions. It is considered best practice to align the blocks with school terms.

Centres can run multiple programs across different tiers, venues, or time slots, providing a variety of options for kids.

Activities are designed to be adaptable, allowing coaches to scale them up or down to meet the needs of each participant, ensuring everyone progresses and enjoys their time throughout the season. This flexibility is assessed at the centre level based on participant needs, allowing for a more tailored approach.

Why Term by Term?


This approach offers several benefits:
