- Team Bench | up to 13 players + 3 team officials
- Team lists | Teams to be checked with Bench in PlayHQ
- Match duration | 40 minutes (4x10 minutes) | 2minute/4minute/2minute breaks
- Match timing | Court 1 will hold central timing for all matches on all courts
- Stoppages | time will not be held for stoppages | umpires will continue to signal
- Finals Extra time | games are played to a result: 1-minute break, no changes and no swapping of ends. Played until a team takes a 2-goal advantage.
- Rolling Substitutes | yes, as per rules
- Concussion protocols | as per Netball Australia's community guidelines
- Ladder | Rounds | win = two (2) points; loss = zero (0) points; draw = one (1) point
